Delegate Alfred W. Harris founded present-day Virginia State University (VSU) in 1882. It was then known as Virginia Normal and College Institute and represented the nation's first fully state-assisted college or university for Blacks. Today, only about one-third of VSU's operating budget comes from state funding.

Acomprehensive university, VSU is one of two land-grant institutions in the Commonwealth of Virginia. Our mission is to promote and sustain academic programs that integrate instruction, research, and extension/public service in a design most responsive to the needs and endeavors of individuals within our scope of influence.

The University educates over 4,600 students who are majoring in one of 34 undergraduate programs leading to a bachelor's degree and 18 graduate level, master's and doctoral programs.

Ultimately, the University is dedicated to the promotion of knowledgeable, perceptive, and humane citizens – secure in their self-awareness, equipped for personal fulfillment, sensitive to the needs and aspirations of others, and committed to assuming productive roles in an ever-changing global society.

Greetings.

The Virginia State University Foundation Board of Trustees and staff is pleased to express our appreciation for the support we receive from the Office of Institutional Advancement (OIA). Your partnership is proving to be invaluable as we continue to strengthen our university's financial position in a very competitive environment.

The Virginia State University Foundation serves as an affiliated organization with a mission of assisting the University through financial support and financial management services. In fiscal year 2022, Foundation endowments and operating funds given by corporations, friends, and alumni, provided the University with \$696,920 in scholarships, \$252,144 for Athletics, and \$547,561 to Programs for an approximate total of \$1.5 million.

Virginia State University's students and staff continue to be challenged in many unprecedented ways. However, the OIA's significant fundraising progress and alumni engagement will help to relieve some of the financial pressures on both students and the University.

The Foundation has created "Foundation Fellows" as part of its plan to educate recent graduates of Virginia State University on the value of giving. The Fellows will be non-voting members of the VSU Foundation and will serve for a period of two years. At any given time, the Foundation can have up to 6 Fellows. The Fellows will be encouraged to reach out to current students and graduates to teach them about the Foundation and to encourage them to financially support the University and the Foundation. From a succession planning perspective, any of these Fellows can be appointed to the Foundation Board with full rights and benefits.

The Foundation thanks OIA for its dedication and commitment as Virginia State University continues to touch and influence the lives of our students.

Christian Cozart

How did this scholarship assist you?

"My name is Christian Cozart, and I am a senior mass communications major and marketing minor from West Orange, New Jersey. While growing up in West Orange, New Jersey, my family and I spent most of our time in Paterson, New Jersey. Jordan Cleaves' untimely death shocked the Paterson community and our VSU football team; he was a nineteen-year-old man with unrealized dreams and VSU experiences. This scholarship allows me to realize my dreams and enjoy the full benefits of a VSU education."

How has Greater Happened Here for you?

"While here at Virginia State University, I gained a leadership role as the president of The National Association for the Advancement of Colored People and membership in the Virginia State Chapter of the National Society of Leadership and Success. The VSU Fulbright experience provides opportunities to study and teach abroad

Virginia State University has been named a 2022 Fulbright Historically Black College and University (HBCU) Institutional Leader. Fulbright HBCU Institutional Leaders have demonstrated noteworthy support for Fulbright exchange participants during the 2020-2021 and 2021-2022 academic years and have promoted Fulbright program opportunities opportunity to learn, grow, on campus. This is Virginia State and experience other cultur University's first recognition under this new initiative.

The Fulbright Program gives talented and accomplished students, scholars, teachers, artists, and professionals the opportunity to study, teach, and conduct research abroad, and contribute to finding solutions to important international problems.

The announcement of the 19 **Fulbright HBCU Institutional**

Leaders was made by the State Department as HBCÚ leaders, including VSU President, Dr. Makola M. Abdullah, prepare to gather for the White House Initiative's National HBCU Week Conference in Washington, DC. Fulbright opportunities will be highlighted in conference events such as the career and recruitment fair during this week.

VIRGINIA STATE UNIVERSITY

enrolled the University's largest incoming class of new students in more than three decades. In fall 2022, VSU welcomed more than 1700 new students (first-time freshmen and transfer students). This is an increase of more than 550 new students over the fall 2021 semester.

VIRGINIA STATE UNIVERSITY

recorded the single largest year-to-year increase in enrollment in over a decade. In fall 2022, VSU enrollment grew by 348 students for a total enrollment of 4648 students. This is a year-to-year increase of more than 8 percent—topping the 7 percent increase the University experienced in fall 2021.

VIRGINIA STATE UNIVERSITY

expanded its online programs. The new programs include a Bachelor of Science (B.S.) in Hospitality Management, a Bachelor of Science (B.S.) in Nursing, an M.Ed. in Education (Special Education Concentration), a Doctor of Education (Ed.D.) in Educational Administration and Supervision, and a Certification in Homefront Readjustment for the Armed Forces.

VIRGINIA STATE UNIVERSITY

started an innovative program to address the Richmond and Petersburg Teacher Shortage. The VSU program offers free tuition to graduate students who agree to work in the local school systems after obtaining their degree.

VIRGINIA STATE UNIVERSITY

was named a 2022 Fulbright Historically Black College and University (HBCU) Institutional Leader. Fulbright HBCU Institutional Leaders demonstrate outstanding support for Fulbright exchange participants and promote Fulbright program opportunities on campus.

VIRGINIA STATE UNIVERSITY

received a portion of a \$1 million Health Innovation and Research Grant. VSU is one of five HBCUs in the country to be awarded \$200K for visionary projects focusing on health-related research. The Propel Center grant supports faculty and students' world-class research and innovation opportunities.

VIRGINIA STATE UNIVERSITY

joined an initiative that has the potential to impact college debt for thousands of students. Student Freedom Initiative offers an income-contingent alternative to federal Parent PLUS loans.

To be informed of the identity of those serving on the organization's governing board, and to expect the board to exercise prudent judgement in its stewardship responsibilities.



To have access to the organization's most recent financial statements.



To be assured their gifts will be used for the purposes for which they were given.



To receive appropriate acknowledgement and recognition.

PHILANTHROPY is based on voluntary action for the common good. It is a tradition of giving and sharing that is primary to the quality of life. To assure that philanthropy merits the respect and trust of the general public, and that donors and prospective donors can have full confidence in the not-for-profit organizations and causes they are asked to support, we declare that all donors have these rights:
